

UNDER THE MISCHIEVOUS MOON AN EVENING WITH JILL BARBER

COQUITLAM, BC November 21, 2011 – Canadian chanteuse and JUNO nominee **Jill Barber** brings her acclaimed album, *Mischievous Moon* to audiences across Quebec, Ontario and Western Canada this fall and will grace the Evergreen Stage on Thursday, December 1 at 8pm.

Barber and her five-piece band started the tour in Quebec for a 36-date run back to the west. Fans can expect an evening full of Barber's passion, charm and classic, old world sound. For full show listings see below.

Mischievous Moon released in April 2011 debuted at #1 on the Canadian jazz charts and held the top position for 13 weeks. The lead single, "Tell Me," has become a staple at both CBC and jazz stations in across the country. The single was also recorded in French (Dis-moi) and has garnered significant airplay on Quebec jazz radio stations and the video has been in rotation at MusicMax. Celebrating the release of *Mischievous Moon* early this year, Barber has performed at Massey Hall with Michael Kaeshammer and has headlined the Halifax Jazz Festival, Ottawa Jazz Festival as well as a sold out Club Soda performance at the Montreal Jazz Festival this summer. Barber continues to receive great acclaim for her latest album and glowing live reviews for her ability to enthrall and capture audiences of all ages.
